RobotWorx' partnership with Marion CAN DO! began in 2005. Owner Keith Wanner was looking to relocate his [industrial robotics](#) company from Delaware, Ohio, to a more affordable area. While searching the Internet, he found the Marion Can DO! website and realized the Marion area matched RobotWorx' needs. Wanner decided to purchase one of the online property listings, a West Fairground Street warehouse.

Moving a business into a new area isn't easy, but Marion CAN DO! made the transition a smooth one. The nonprofit group has had a key role from the beginning.
